Scholarship Rules

- 1. Scholarships awarded are open to any graduating Northside I.S.D. high school senior who has been an active member, in good standing, of the ASTA FFA program OR an active member of a 4-H club that is allowed to exhibit at the Walter Gerlach Show.
- 2. All applicants must have exhibited at the Walter Gerlach Show for the past two (2) years, this does include Ag. Mech. Projects.
- 3. Special consideration will be given to applicants who have been active in all the livestock shows, judging teams, and leadership.
- 4. Applicants must select either FFA or 4-H activities when filling out this application. <u>Do not mix FFA or 4-H projects, awards, leadership or recognition.</u>
- 5. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's college or university of choice, however; the recipient must be enrolled for the fall semester during the application year.
- 6. The application forms may be obtained at the ASTA FFA Office. Completed applications must be returned to that office by 4:00pm on December 04, 2025
- 7. Please enclose the application in a large, sealed envelope marked Walter Gerlach Buyers Scholarship's indicating FFA or 4-H. (Personal interviews will occur after 6:00 pm on January 6 AND/OR 7, 2026 please mark your calendar.)
- 8. Recipient(s) will be awarded Scholarship certificates during the Walter Gerlach Auction and disbursement of the funds will be made during the first semester of college, after all qualifications have been verified and approved by the Scholarship Committee Chairman.
 - a. Proof of these requirements must accompany the request for disbursement. This request, with all requirements validated, must be mailed to "ASTA FFA Booster Club; Attention Scholarship Committee; P.O. Box 781; Helotes, Texas 78023."
 - b. Proof the recipient is enrolled at a college or university and a paid registration receipt from that college or university.
- 9. Scholarship finalists must be at Walter Gerlach Show Barns by 4:00 PM the day of closing ceremony or lose their scholarship.

All applications will be weighed on the following criteria:

1.	FFA or 4-H activity involvement	30 pts.
2.	WGLS Involvement	20 pts.
3.	Other school activity involvement	10 pts.
4.	Community involvement	10 pts
5.	Personal interview	20 pts.
6.	Grades and attendance	10 pts.
